

BYLAW 600

OUTSIDE COMPETITION

A student on a high school team becomes ineligible if the student competes in a contest on an outside team, in the same sport, during the student's high school season of sport.



CONSEQUENCES



First Offense - Student becomes ineligible for a number of high school contests equal to twice the number of outside contests in which the student participated.



Any Subsequent Offense - Student becomes immediately ineligible in all sports for one year (365 days) from the second infraction.



Team - Games in which a student participated on their high school team after a violation of Bylaw 600 shall be forfeited.

WHAT IS AN OUTSIDE TEAM?

One that is organized through a non-school organization such as: youth teams, AAU teams, club teams, national teams, and community teams.

WHAT ABOUT NON-SCHOOL PRACTICES, CAMPS, & CLINICS?

Individual student-athletes may attend a non-school practice, camp, or clinic during that sport's season of sport.
