Some of the information you might need to complete your application includes:

- ☐ Student's Social Security number and driver's license number (or government issued ID) if available
- ☐ Parents' Social Security number (if available)
- ☐ Parents' federal income tax returns for tax year 2019
- ☐ Records of untaxed income such as child support, TANF, interest income, veteran's non-educational benefits, social security benefits
- ☐ Student's 2019 federal income tax return, or evidence of income earned (W-2 form or pay records)
- ☐ Bank account records or statements
- ☐ Records of stocks, bonds or investments (if available)
- ☐ Business records (if available)
- ☐ If not US citizen, bring alien registration card (if available)
- ☐ A list of colleges you are interested in and housing plans

Remember!

To apply for Cal Grant, you must submit a FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application and Cal Grant GPA verification. Public high schools and public charter schools are required to submit their current seniors year students' GPAs, unless the parent or student has opted out. Verify with your school!

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
