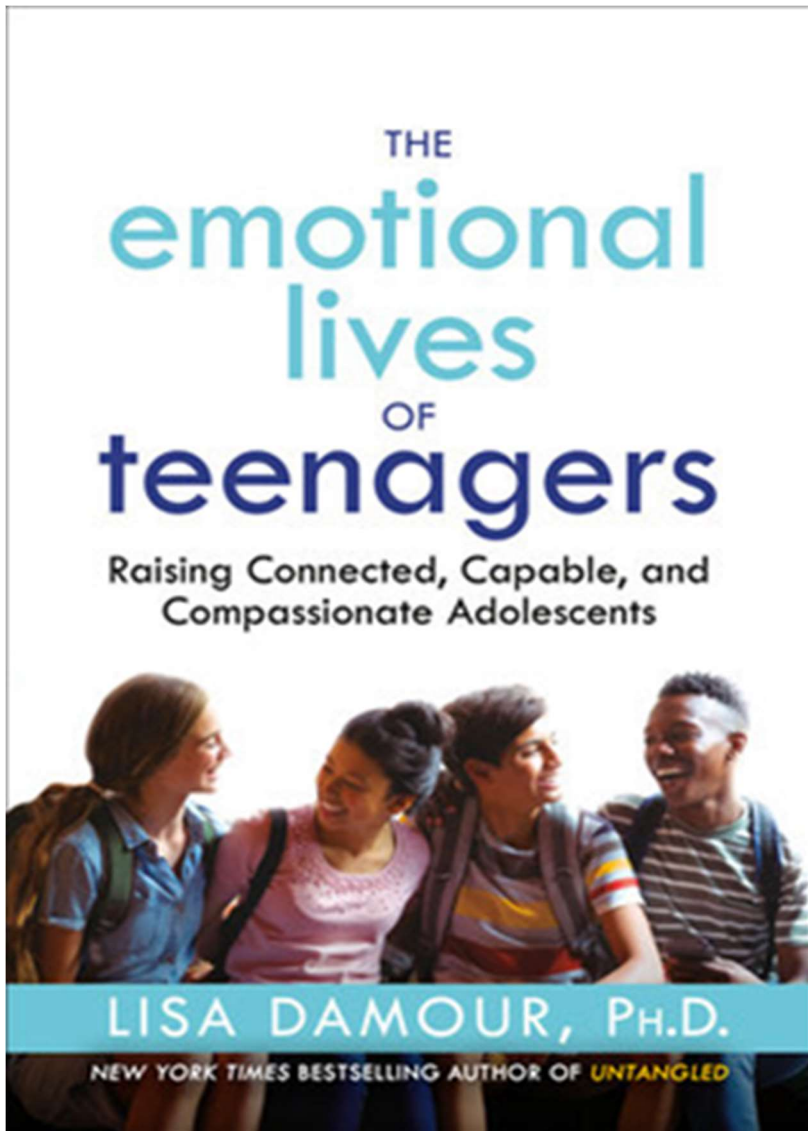

Dr. Damour's latest book is an urgently needed guide to help parents understand their children's intense and often fraught emotional lives.

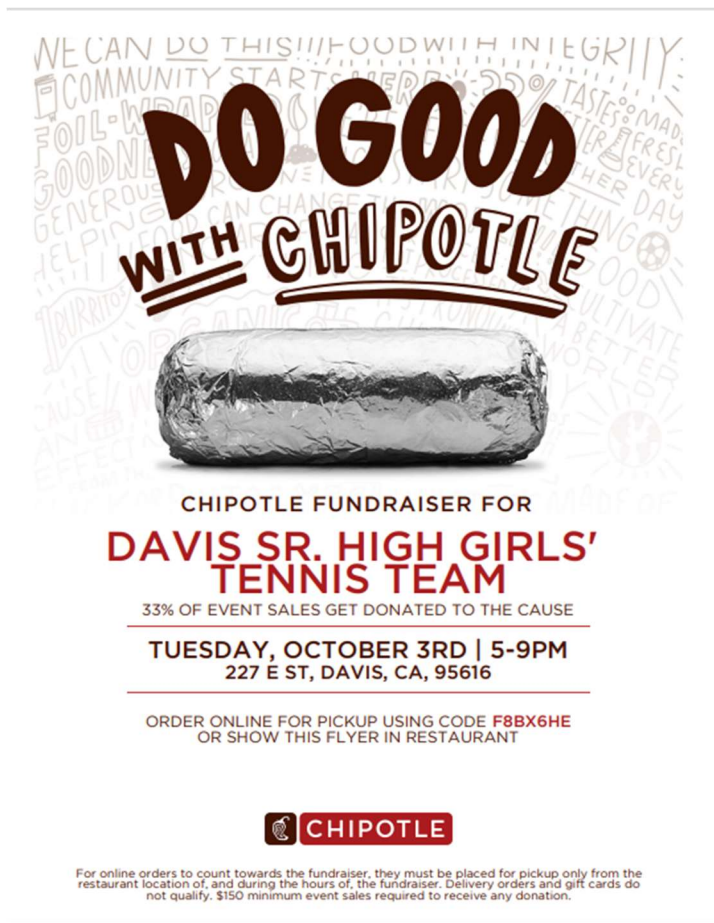
